14 "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. 2 In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am, there you may be also. (John 14:1 – 3)

In our reading from John, Jesus is preparing his disciples for his impending death. Jesus knew his time was short and his disciples were feeling a sense of loss. Their beloved master, with whom they had traveled for the past several years--tells them that he is leaving them, and they can't come with him. They are sad and confused, their hearts are troubled by this news. They don't know how they can go on without their teacher.

Yet, Jesus assures that they have nothing to fear, for he is going to prepare a place for them. He promises that one day he will return and bring them to that place and that one day, all of creation will be drawn together in the heavenly kingdom of God.

The world, and life, is full of uncertainties. There seems to be so much evil in the world, so much hatred, so much pain. It can be easy for us to focus on the negative. We can sometimes get the impression that God isn't there; or if God is, that God just doesn't care. We can get so focused upon the evils of the world that we fail to look through it all and see the good. We can get so wrapped up in our selfish view of things, that we ignore God's good intentions for us.

Jesus disciples also felt this kind of uncertainty when he told them about his impending death. What is Jesus talking about? How will they survive if he leaves them? Where will they go? Why is everything changing?

But Jesus never promises that things will be easy. Jesus never says that you won't struggle, that you won't have questions.

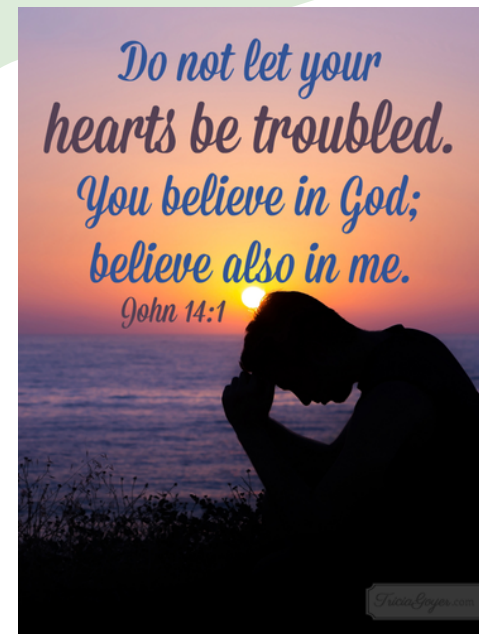
What Jesus does promise is to always be with you. When things get hard, Jesus doesn't abandon you, but it right there with you. Life can be hard, but you do not go through it alone.

God will not leave you forsaken. God has promised to care for you always. God so loves the world, God so loves you...that God gave God's only son to die on a cross....that you may have eternal life.

Death, and pain, and sorrow, don't have the final word. On the cross, Jesus opened his arms to all, and through his death and resurrection, you have nothing to fear. The place that Jesus has prepared for you and for all of creation is a place where pain and sorrow are no more, where suffering is no more, a place where you dwell forever with God. The place that Jesus prepares is a place of peace, a place of everlasting joy, and a place where you are united together with all those who have gone before us.
